
# OUR VISION

# TAIOHI IMPACT STORIES

## TEWHAIA

Before I joined the Waitara Taiohi Trusts youth programs, I faced many risks. Growing up, gangs and alcohol abuse were all around me. This environment made me lose interest in education and pushed me towards gangs in Waitara from a young age. My first connection with a youth worker in Waitara evolved into a mentoring relationship, which became crucial for me.

Now, three years later, through the Waitara Taiohi Trust Internship, I am a qualified and passionate youth worker. My goal is to support young people who've faced similar challenges as have. The mentoring and supportive programs, especially "Loyal Leaders," were life-changing for me. They helped me re-engage with education and even helped me pass level three NCEA, a milestone in my family.

The impact of youth work on my life inspired me to do the same for young people in my community. That's why I pursued the WTT Internship to become a certified Youth Worker.

## TAIVAKA

Talofa, my name is Taivaka. I am currently a student at Waitara High School, and I am honoured to be in my final year as Head Girl. I'm a proud Pasifika islander, originally from Kiribati and Tuvalu. I was born in Tamaki Makaurau but later relocated to the lovely town of Waitara.

Being in Waitara the challenges I've faced involved having self-doubt and not having real motivation to do anything. I never knew my purpose in life and I was really confused about what or where I was going in life. I had very low self-esteem and it'd be to the point where I would isolate myself from the world, basically drowning in my negative thoughts. So growing up I struggled with opening up about anything I was going through because of judgement but meeting the WTT youth workers through the programme loyal leaders created positive relationships that helped me to share my pain, my hurt and my struggles. Where I lacked in building myself up, the youth workers picked me up and wanted to journey with me to grow in resilience. They've allowed me to feel my comfort in my living, they've allowed me to know my worth and they've allowed me to know that it's okay to not be okay and that I'm never alone. One of the main reasons why I accepted help is because of their genuineness. They've made me see the brighter things in life and that has shaped me to be the woman I am today.

### KALANI

As a 17-year-old guy, I can't even put into words how much Waitara Taiohi Trust has turned my life around. I was on a rocky path in school, close to being kicked out due to my troubles with drugs and a general lack of direction. Then came the turning point when I joined the Loyal Leaders and Inspire programs with the Trust.

The youth workers there weren't just mentors; they were real-life inspirations. They didn't just listen and encourage; they showed us how to grow, serve the community, grow in my whakapapa and take on leadership roles. It was like a lightbulb switched on in my head.





Loyal Leaders is a dynamic program offered by the Waitara Taiohi Trust, empowering young individuals aged 15 to 25 to grow as leaders and make a positive impact in their community. Through a series of engaging activities and structured sessions, participants develop essential life skills, build meaningful relationships and connections, and cultivate leadership qualities rooted in rangatiratanga principles.

Outcomes: Increased access to opportunities, Better understanding in who they are and can be, and Greater capability to create opportunities for others.







The Internship program by the Waitara Taiohi Trust is a transformative journey aimed at creating employment pathways for taiohi (young people) by providing comprehensive professional training as qualified youth workers. Through this program, taiohi gain invaluable practical experience, mentorship, and educational support to kickstart their careers in the field of youth work.

#### INSPIRE 2023 - now

The Inspire Program by the Waitara Taiohi Trust is a dynamic initiative designed to ignite passion, creativity, and personal growth among taiohi (young people). Through engaging workshops, mentorship, and community projects, the program aims to inspire taiohi to discover their strengths, pursue their dreams, and make positive contributions to their communities.

This program is run during club time at Waitara High School as well as on weekends. It has already led to 4 community events, all created and run by taiohi.




